Any administrator, principal, or person speaking in an official capacity will conduct his or her assignment from the standpoint of the best interests of the Nashua School District, and not as a representative of his or her personal ideas, feelings, or point of view.

The Superintendent and Director of Communications determine how and when school district information will be shared with stakeholders. The primary sources of regular communication are electronic, utilizing the school district's mass communication software.

The school district's website publishes both need-to-know and nice-to-know information accurately and in a timely manner.

The Director of Communications is responsible for coordinating information shared with the media, working with each school or program's administrator as needed.

District employees seek approval from the Superintendent or the Director of Communications prior to sharing school district information with the media.
